# Black Smoky Eyes

Smoky eyes are already a big style these days and there is no sign this unique craze is perishing. Here we provide you with step-by-step directions on the ways to have the best **smoky eye**.

The true secret to the ideal smoky eye is right blending. You need to ensure colors are mixed together thoroughly. Additionally, you need to pair mild base shades with rich darker shades. Nice blends include: Gentle gold base together with heavy purple on the top, champagne base together with vibrant blue and green hue with peach base.

The important thing to keeping eye shadow from melting directly into the eyelid crease as the day moves on is to maintain eyelids oil-free. To achieve this begin with an eyeshadow base (also known as "primer"). Just swipe the primer along the eye and allow it to dry so that you can go to the next phase.

For shade at the base you will want to work with an eyeliner pencil since they are simplest to smudge. After the lines are drawn, run your little finger on it to smudge this line. It's also possible to use a little shadow to have complete smudge effect.

Merge deeper color; however keep darker color under the crease. Once you've got the base and eye liner on, you're ready to have the smoky effect. You'll need a deeper eyeshadow tone. With the help of an eyeshadow brush, merge color starting at your eyelash line, and then blend together. You should merge color into the eyelash line to ensure the eye liner fades away. Stop deep color at crease. The true secret here is to merge.

Use eyeliner. If you are going for a standard dark, brownish or grayish smoky eye, use liner in one of these shades over the upper eyelash line, drawing line fuller in the center of eye. In case you are going for a jewel-toned eye, line eyes using a crimson, blue or dark green eyeliner.

Finish off with numerous fine layers of mascara. You might want to apply some layers of mascara so that the eyelashes become thicker and darker. In case you want to have curled eyelashes, curl them with an eyelash curler. Make sure you keep the lips nude. While applying heavy make-up, like red lips or smoky eyes, concentrate on either your lips or eyes, and never both.

For a little bit of fun, consider using blue or crimson mascara. It'll make green eyes pop. Eyeliner doesn't always have to be in pencil form. Make-up specialists understand that eyeshadows produce some of the finest eyeliners. To get this done get an eyeliner brush, drench it, and then pat moist brush into the darker shadow. This gives a deep, correct line. You can even make use of the darker shadows without having to wet brush first. In either case, eyeliner is essential for great smoky eye.

Hope these simple tips on creating the perfect **smoky eyes** will have you rocking the stunning smoky eye look yourself.
